



## Priming your Vanderburgh Humidor

Although you are most likely eager to introduce your fine cigars into your new Vanderburgh humidor, a small amount of patience is required before your humidor is ready to accept your cigars. A very overlooked component to humidification is properly preparing your humidor prior to introduction of your fine cigars. This simple procedure will only take you about about 5 minutes, but it will allow your Vanderburgh Humidor to operate at peak performance.



Since the Spanish Cedar on your Vanderburgh Humidor is completely dry, the wood may actually pull the moisture from your cigars, potentially drying them out. Make sure your CigarSpa electronic humidification system has been removed from the humidor. Take some pure distilled water and dampen a soft, lint-free, clean cotton cloth. Take this cloth and carefully wipe down the insides of all the Spanish Cedar lining, allowing the moisture to absorb into the wood.

Avoid over-dampening the wood, as you don't want to stain the beautiful cedar. Close the lid of your humidor and let the moisture absorb into the wood for about 12 hours.

The only thing that is required now, is to set your CigarSpa back inside the humidor. Refer to the CigarSpa instructions to properly set up the humidification system. Your CigarSpa will take all the worry and care out of preserving your cigars to flawless perfection. Your Vanderburgh Humidor, with your CigarSpa electronic humidification system should perfectly preserve your cigars for years and years to come.
